Empty containers retain product residue, continue to obey safety and handling

precautions. Contact with ammonia and amine-based compounds can generate toxic chloramine compounds. Contact with acids can release dangerous chlorine gas.

Other Precautions: Keep out of reach of children. Mix only with water. Do not use or mix with other cleaning products.
