

#### SECTION IV - FIRST AID INFORMATION

**First Aid Procedures:**

**Ingestion:** Dilute by drinking 1-2 glasses of water. Do NOT induce vomiting. If symptoms persist, consult a physician.

**Eye Contact:** Flush eyes thoroughly with lukewarm water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, consult a physician.

**Skin Contact:** Rinse exposed area with water. If irritation persists, consult a physician.

**Inhalation:** Leave dusty area. In rare cases a respiratory reaction can occur which may include tightness of chest and difficulty breathing. If this occurs, seek medical attention immediately.
