Dear Customer,

Maintex began implementing GHS regulations in mid 2013 to enable Maintex to comply with GHS requirements by June 1<sup>st</sup> 2015. In May 2015, we emailed and/or sent letters in mail to all Maintex customers indicating our transition to new GHS compliant labels and Safety Data Sheets beginning June 1<sup>st</sup>, as well as included Safety Data Sheets for purchased products. Please note products such as Cosmetics (Body Wash), Disinfectants, Antibacterial, and Hand Sanitizers are exempt from GHS requirements, but will still include an updated Safety Data Sheet.

Maintex may continue to distribute products manufactured and labeled prior to

June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 with a HCS 2012-compliant labels and MSDS (If SDS is not available)

through December 1, 2015, due to our "due diligence" and "good faith", which we have

demonstrated in accordance with the OSHA's Relaxed Enforcement Policy. More
