## 2. Hazards Identification

Emergency overview **FLAMMABLE**  
**CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE.** Aerosol. Pressurized container may explode when exposed to heat or flame.  
 Irritating to eyes. Prolonged exposure may cause chronic effects.

Potential health effects  
 Routes of exposure Ingestion, Inhalation, Skin contact.  
 Eyes Causes eye irritation.  
 Skin Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Prolonged or repeated contact can result in defatting and drying of the skin which may result in skin irritation and dermatitis (rash). Intentional misuse by concentrating and inhaling the product can be harmful or fatal.  
 Inhalation Intentional misuse by concentrating and inhaling the product can be harmful or fatal.  
 Ingestion Exposure by ingestion of an aerosol is unlikely. Components of the product may be absorbed into the body by ingestion.  
 Target organs Central nervous system.  
 Chronic effects May cause central nervous system disorder (e.g., narcosis involving a loss of coordination, weakness, fatigue, mental confusion, and blurred vision) and/or damage.

## 4. First Aid Measures

First aid procedures  
 Eye contact Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Get medical attention if irritation develops or persists.  
 Skin contact Immediately take off all contaminated clothing. Wash off with warm water and soap. Get medical attention if irritation develops or persists.  
 Inhalation Move to fresh air. Oxygen or artificial respiration if needed. Do not use mouth-to-mouth method if victim inhaled the substance. Induce artificial respiration with the aid of a pocket mask equipped with a one-way valve or other proper respiratory medical device. Get medical attention immediately.  
 Ingestion If material is ingested, immediately contact a poison control center. Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting without advice from poison control center. If vomiting occurs naturally, have victim lean forward to reduce risk of aspiration.
