3 Hazards Identification

Emergency Overview: May cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid skin and eye contact.

CAUTION:

Contact with Eyes: Direct contact with concentrated product may cause moderate irritation.

Contact with Skin: Repeated or prolonged contact with skin may cause irritation, drying and/or dermatitis.

Skin Absorption: No data.

Ingestion Symptoms: Irritation, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea.

Inhalation Symptoms: Excessive inhalation of the concentrate can cause nasal and respiratory irritation, dizziness, headache and anesthetic effects.

4 First Aid Measures

Ingestion: If ingested, do NOT induce vomiting. Give moderate amounts of water to wash out mouth area and dilute remaining residue. Seek medical attention.
