Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Drink one or two glasses of water to dilute product. Get medical attention. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

SECTION VIII: SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION

Respiratory Protection: Not required with normal usage of water soluble packets. Mixers / loaders and applicators must wear a dust / mist filtering respirator meeting NIOSH standards of at least N-95, R-95 or P-95.
Ventilation: Provide good general ventilation. Local exhaust ventilation may be necessary for some operations.

SECTION IX: SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

Precautions; Handling & Storing: Store in cool; dry location. Avoid temperatures above 85 °F. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not contaminate drinking water, food or feed.
